ITEM	WHERE/HOW	SUGGESTIONS
Aerosol cans (empty)	In the trash	
Aluminum cans	Blue Cart	Rinsed - No foil or pie plates
Anti freeze	(Notes 1 & 4)	Try any garage or marina
Appliances	(Note 2)	Donate, if still usable
Batteries (auto/boat)	(Note 1)	Also, try any garage or boat yard
Batteries (home)	(Note 4)	Lowes and other stores will accept rechargeable ones
Books	Blue Cart	Remove Hard binders
Bottles (glass or plastic)	Blue Cart	Rinsed
Brush	(Note 1)	Try mulching and composting
Cardboard	Blue Cart or County Drop-Off	Knocked down & flattened
Catalogs & flyers	Blue Cart	
Chemicals	(Note 4)	DO NOT DUMP OR PLACE IN TRASH
Construction debris	(Note 3)	Very small amounts OK in trash
Fluorescent light bulbs	Tidelands Electric (745-4127)	Located in Grantsboro
Food waste	In the trash	Try composting
Fuel (gas, diesel, heating)	(Notes 1 & 4)	DO NOT DUMP OR PLACE IN TRASH
Furniture (Metal or non metal)	Grantsboro transfer station or hold for bulk pick-up day	
Glass containers	Blue Cart	Rinsed - No window glass, bulbs, crystal, drinking glasses, etc.
Grass clippings	(Note 1)	Cut it and leave it or try mulching
Junk Mail	Blue Cart	Try Removal List
Leaves	(Note 1)	Try Mulching & composting
Magazines	Blue Cart	Re-use - trade with friends
Motor oil	(Note 1)	Try any garage or marina
Newsprint (any color)	Blue Cart	Includes glossies & flyers
Office paper	Blue Cart	
Paint cans	(Note 1)	Empty or less then 1" OK in trash
Pesticides	(Note 4)	Try organic alternatives
Plastic bags	In the trash or to super markets	NO BAGS IN WITH RECYCLING, EVER!
Plastic bottles	Blue Cart	BOTTLES Only! (Rinsed)
Plastic packing "peanuts"	In the trash or shipping companies	Try Village Graphics in Grantsboro
Propane tanks	Grantsboro transfer station or Note 4	Must be empty. Give to friend or neighbor to consume
Scrap metal	(Note 1)	Try junk dealers
Telephone books	Blue Cart	
Tin cans	Blue Cart	Rinse
Tires	(Note 1)	Leave with seller of new tires
Tree stumps	(Note 1)	Contractors are responsible
Yard debris	(Note 1)	Try composting

NOTES:

2. Small ones in trash, large at curbside on bulk/white goods pick-up day. Call 249-0555.
3. Construction debris is not acceptable for collection. Contractors must dispose of their own
