

Town of Oriental – Board of Commissioners Continued Meeting
April 12, 2007

The Oriental Town Board of Commissioners met on Thursday, April 12, 2007 at 9:00 am at the Oriental Town Hall. Present were Mayor pro tem Johnson and Commissioners Bohmert, Herlands, Inger, and Venturi. Also present was Planning Board member Cox, as well as 22 members of the public.

Mayor pro tem Johnson reopened the meeting and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PROPERTY PURCHASE: Commissioner Inger gave a recap on the intention of purchasing land at this time. Commissioner Bohmert and Venturi also gave their views on why the Town's intention to invest in itself is a good idea.

MOTION: Commissioner Herlands made a motion to schedule a public hearing on April 30, 2007 at 7:00 pm at the Town Hall to further discuss the land purchase and to receive public input.

The town attorney will be asked what appraisal info can/should be released to the public at this time.

STAGGERED TERMS: Briefly discussed but no action taken.

PROPOSED U.S. CELLULAR TOWER: A citizen raised this subject but as the proposed site is not within the Town limits, no action was taken.

MOTION: Commissioner Bohmert made the motion to adjourn. Second by Commissioner Inger. Vote 4-0.
