

Town of Oriental – Board of Commissioners Agenda Workshop Meeting  
April 2, 2009

The Oriental Town Board of Commissioners met on Thursday, April 2 at 4:30 pm at the Oriental Town Hall.

Present were: Mayor Sage and Commissioners Cox, Kellam and Styron  
Town Manager Cahoon

Mayor Sage opened the workshop meeting at 4:50 pm.

Mayor Sage stated that the tape recorder malfunctioned during the closed session portion of the March 3 meeting therefore Ms. Wagoner could not write the minutes. Commissioner Inger will provide the minutes at the Tuesday meeting.

The board reviewed the agenda and decided that the town attorney does not need to attend the meeting on Tuesday night.

#16 – CAMP CREEK DRIVE – Briefly discussed this project and Commissioner Cox questioned the status of this subdivision.

It was pointed out that there is a mistake on the GMO map; the road that is shown behind and between the post office and Croaker Town is a private road and needs to be removed.

#17 – SCHEDULE PUBLIC HEARINGS - Commissioner Kellam asked if the proposed changes to the GMO were substantial (some are). Mr. Cahoon produced a format amendment to the ordinance approved by the Planning Board at their March 25 meeting. The board then discussed 'vesting'.

#19 – NON-AGENDA ITEMS – Commissioner Kellam will give a report on a meeting she attended in Raleigh on March 14 and a franchise agreement with Progress Energy will be discussed.
