

Town of Oriental – Board of Commissioners Agenda Workshop
October 29, 2009

The Town of Board of Commissioners met on Thursday, October 29 at 4:30 pm at the Oriental Town Hall.

Mayor Pro-tem Styron opened the agenda workshop.

PLANNING BOARD – Commissioner Cox reported that a refund is due to Mr. Joe Wakefield of Camp Creek as he was erroneously charged a tap fee.

POLICE REPORT – More break-ins have occurred during the past month as well as the complaints made against the Chief. Of the two officers being considered for the part time position, one is awaiting approval from his superiors to be able to work here.

TOWN COMPUTER – As the computer used for the water billing is breaking down;

MOTION: Commissioner Cox made a motion to approve spending up to \$1000 for a new computer. Ms. Artley will get the spec requirements for the water billing system and get them to Mr. Cox. Second by Commissioner Inger. Vote 4-0.

OLD BUSINESS – Commissioner Cox explained that there are a few unfinished business items that he would like to try to resolve before the new board takes office in December.

COMMISSIONERS' COMMENT – Commissioner Cox reported that he attended a Census meeting in Bayboro and stressed the importance of peoples' cooperation in getting an accurate count as it affects Powell Bill money, ETJ and annexation.

NON-AGENDA - Mayor Sage asked, via Mrs. Artley, the Board to consider revisiting the Noise Ordinance as was promised when it was adopted.
