

Town of Oriental – Board of Commissioners Agenda Workshop
June 25, 2009

The Oriental Town Board of Commissioners met on Thursday, June 25 at 4:30 pm at the Oriental Town Hall.

9 members of the public

While waiting for a third commissioner to arrive to make the quorum, Mayor Sage opened the floor to discuss the public's concerns about rumors of an infiltration pond going in at Sea Horse Landing on White Farm Road. As the developers have not approached the Town about changing their permit, the rumors are unfounded at this time.

Mayor Sage opened the agenda workshop meeting at 4:50 pm.

TOWN ATTORNEY REPORT - The Board agreed that Mr. Davis need not attend the July 7th meeting.

TOWN MANAGER'S REPORT – Mr. Cahoon reviewed his report. A special meeting will be arranged to meet with Mr. David Singleton to review last year's audit.

WATER BILLING / LATE PAYMENTS – The Board agreed to handle late water bill payers by hanging tags on their doors warning that their water will be turned off unless payment is received that same day.

SPVFD – VERIFICATION FROM MUNICIPALITY – Mr. Cahoon was asked to update the resolution.

POLICE - Mr. Cahoon informed the board that the town that was interested in the police boat has decided against taking it. Regarding the police car obtained through the GHSP Grant;

MOTION: Commissioner Bohmert made a motion to return the police car. Second by Commissioner Cox. Vote 3-0.

BUDGET AMENDMENTS –

MOTION: Commissioner Inger made a motion to approve the budget amendments.
Second by Commissioner Cox, Vote 3-0.

AGENDA – The General Ordinance Changes will be removed from item #16 – Set Public Hearing and moved to a consent agenda.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST STATEMENT - Mr. Cahoon was asked to look into the state statutes and to match the statement with them.
