Town Board of Commissioners  
Public Hearing to Propose and Adopt the 2014-2015 Budget  
June 18, 2014

A Public Hearing was held on Wednesday, June 18, 2014 at 7:00 PM to propose and adopt the Town Budget for the 2014-2015 Fiscal Year. Mayor Sage determined a quorum to be present and opened the Public Hearing with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PRESENT:** Mayor Sage, Commissioners Overcash, White, Venturi, Summers and Winfrey, Town Manager Miller, Police Captain Moore, Deputy Town Clerk Beyer and public

The floor was opened to the public for comment; Mr. Bill Hines reminded the Board of the upcoming invoice for the booms that will confined major spills in the waters near Town. Commissioner Venturi reminded him that those monies will come out of the 2013-2014 budget,

Ms. Grace Evans feels that the recycle fee of \$1 that will be implemented July 1, 2014 will keep citizens from recycling, and also suggested the Town consider porta-johns for the South Avenue dock property instead of building a permanent building.

There being no further public comment, a Motion was made to close the Public Hearing.
