

Town of Oriental Town Board  
Agenda Workshop Meeting  
July 31, 2014

The Town of Oriental Town Board of Commissioners held its regularly scheduled Agenda Workshop Meeting on Thursday, July 31, 2014 at 4:00 PM. Mayor Pro Tem Venturi determined a quorum to be present, and opened the meeting.

Mayor Pro Tem Venturi opened the floor to public comment. Ms. Grace Evans expressed concern over the wildlife ramp and unattended vehicles. She felt that better patrolling of the area may deter this activity.

Mr. Warren Johnson inquired as to the shrimp trawlers tying up at the Town Docks. Mayor Pro Tem Venturi stated that this issue would be addressed at length at Tuesday's Town Board Meeting.

There being no further public comment, the Board moved on to the Agenda.

Mr. Sam Meyers will present a report on the recent Rotary Boat Show, and the plans for next year's show. Mr. Meyers will also discuss the Rotary's involvement in the Habitat for Humanity home being built in Oriental. Mayor Pro Tem Venturi tasked Deputy Town Clerk Beyer with contacting Mr. Meyers and having him add to his presentation the results of the Rotary booth at the Croaker Fest.

Mayor Pro Tem Venturi added Add Chapter R Harbor Waterfronts Committee to the Agenda.

**MOTION:** Mayor Pro Tem Venturi made a Motion to add Chapter R Harbor Waterfronts Committee to the Agenda. Commissioner Overcash seconded. Motion passed 3-0

Town Manager proposed amendments to Chapter S, Town Rates and Fees, parking ticket fees.

There will be a Budget Amendment presented concerning the Town Hall Generator repairs and the Powell Bill funds allocated to pothole repair.

The Water Advisory Board has 2 vacancies; O&M Manual moving forward towards its completion; and Mr. Larry Dechesser has requested to be reappointed to the WAB as a Member.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned. Commissioner Overcash made a Motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Winfrey seconded. Motion passed 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 4:40 PM.
