

Tree Board Meeting

Old Business: The Dorothy Whipple Tree will be moved to Town Hall this winter by use of a hydraulic tree spade. Bob Miller will make the arrangements.

Ten Safety Vests have been purchased and are at the "Pigeon Hole" for printing of the logo on the back. Toni Leavitt showed a sample of the logo. Each Board Member will be responsible for a vest. The vest is to be returned to the Town if no longer serving on the Tree Board.

Winter Planting: Planting around Town Hall will be done as soon as possible. Board will survey available sites after the meeting. Suggestions from residents' will be encouraged. Crepe Myrtles will be planted in front of the Sharr residence. These crepes will replace the trees removed by the power company.

New Inventory: State Urban Forest Council will be posting the new inventory system on their web site. Bob Miller will follow up.

New Business: The County will be spraying the baseball infield at the Rec Park. Tree Board has requested a member be present to be sure the conditions are satisfactory to control over spray.

The meeting was adjourned following a survey of planting sites around Town Hall.
