Town Board Agenda Workshop Meeting
November 26, 2013

A Town of Oriental Town Board Agenda Workshop Meeting was held on Tuesday, November 26, 2013 at 4:00 PM.

Mayor Sage called the meeting to order at 4:00 PM and determined a quorum to be present.

PRESENT: Mayor Sage, Commissioners Bessette, Johnson, Summers, Town Manager Cutler, Deputy Town Clerk Beyer and Public

Commissioner Venturi arrived at 4:09 PM.

ABSENT: Commissioner Styron

Mayor Sage proceeded with the Agenda items, stating that the December 3, 2013 Town Board meeting would begin with outgoing board occupying the dais, and approval of the Consent Agenda. The outgoing Board would then step down from the dais, and the new Board will be sworn in and take their seats on the dais. The Mayor Pro Tem will be seated to the right of the Mayor, and the most senior commissioner(s) next, followed by the newest commissioners occupying the outermost seats.

The Planning Board and the Board of Adjustment both have vacancies and a list of candidates has been included in the agenda packet. The Planning Board has 4 vacancies and the Board of Adjustment also has 4 vacancies. The Commissioners will be given ballots, and the top vote getters will be appointed to the respective Boards.

Commissioner Summers requested adding Agenda Item 7a. Reserve Town Docks for flotilla.

Public Comment:

Joe Valinoti discussed the Vegetative Bag program; he is against keeping the program implemented, and finds it cost prohibitive. He suggested mowing over the leaves to mulch them back into the lawn.

The deadline to send the bags back to the manufacturer was November 22, 2013, but the sales representative indicated that if that date was missed, the town would still be able to return the unused bags.

There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Sage asked for a Motion to Adjourn. Commissioner Venturi made a Motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Bessette seconded. Motion passed 4-0. Meeting adjourned at 4:39 PM.
