

Park and Recreation May 10, 2022, 3:00pm, Board Meeting Minutes

Agenda Items

1. Sand Box at Recreation Park. Decided to purchase "play" sand. Frank Roe contacted Forrest Farm and obtain an estimate of \$956. Town Funding has been identified and Commissioners have approved (5/24/22 - Budget Meeting) purchase. Sand has been order waiting on delivery date. Will request Work Order for repair of base lining - prior to delivery of sand.
2. BBQ Grill at Recreation Park. Decided to purchase grill. Board selected base grill \$259.99 for the initial installation. Frank Roe assisted with identifying grill to purchased which did not requiring shipping fees. Grill has been delivered. Requested Work Order for PW staff to install grill. Park and Rec Team will identify site and assist with installation.
3. Manager Mill instructed Board to purchase needed items in May and to avoid purchasing in June - just prior to year end closing. Team has identified items and submitted purchase requests.
4. Park and Recreation Board voted to support the Kids Park at the 2022 Croaker Event, Saturday, July 2, 9:00am to 5:00pm. Park and Rec team will help staff two hour coverage schedule. Duties include: assisting children and vendors with activities, collect money for tickets, and help setup/take down. Manager Miller suggest we leverage the Town volunteers and will assist with communication. Park and Rec to provide scheduling slots.
5. Horse Shoes - open item to schedule Park and Rec team to install.
6. Open House (5/5/22) comments: Stan Ishlman, representing 40+ Pickle Ball players offered assistance and support for the development of Pickle Ball courts. Walking path interest mentioned several times. Several positive comments regarding the general improvement with the conditions of the parks.
