# Tree Board Minutes

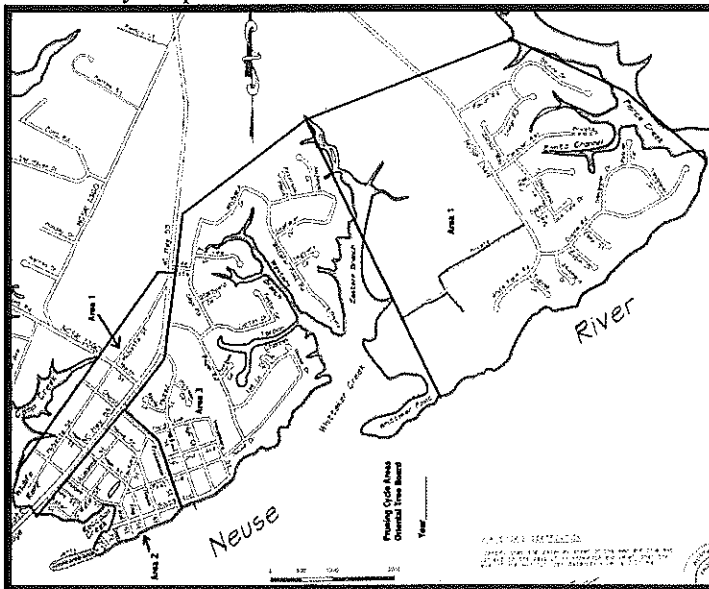
May 23, 2023
