

Town of Oriental  
Town Board Agenda Workshop  
April 30, 2015

The Town Board of Oriental held its regularly scheduled Agenda Workshop Meeting on Thursday, April 30, 2015 at 4:00 PM. Mayor Sage determined a quorum to be present, and opened the meeting.

**PRESENT:** Mayor Sage, Commissioners White, Overcash, Summers, Venturi and Winfrey, Town Manager Miller, and Administrative Assistant Dimond.

Mayor Sage read through the draft agenda and there were no additional comments on or objections to the following items;

- The consent agenda; four sets of minutes, including two sets of budget meeting minutes.
- A budget amendment to move General Fund police lines (including unbudgeted income) to police items to fund audio/surveillance equipment for Chief Moore.
- Board/Committee Reports.
- A Public Hearing for a Special Use Permit to change the use of 402 Academy Street from residential to residential/ vacation rental.

There was no public comment.

The Commissioners discussed adding the Paws Parade to the annual street closures resolution. Town Manager Miller asked if the Commissioners would like to considering adding the Rotary Club In-Water Boat Show to the resolution. Following discussion, the Commissioners agreed that they would rather have Rotary obtain permission from local businesses every year, seeing as they are affected by the event.

Town Manager Miller reviewed the highlights of this month's Manager's Report. Commissioner Venturi commented that she had printed out information from the School of Government about staggered Commissioner terms and had highlighted what she would like to point out to the rest of the Board. Commissioner Summers commented that he would like to have the monthly financial report made available by the Agenda Workshop Meetings.

In the Commissioner comment period, Commissioner Summers asked the Board for use of the Town Recreation Park to set up tents for the Paddling in Pamlico Festival, May 23-25, 2015. Without objection, the Board agreed to allocate the space of the Recreation Park for the festival.

**Motion:** Commissioner White motioned to adjourn, Commissioner Overcash seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

The meeting adjourned at 4:24 PM.
