

Town of Oriental
Town Board Agenda Workshop
February 26, 2015

The Town Board of Oriental held its regularly scheduled Agenda Workshop Meeting on Thursday, February 26, 2015 at 4:00 PM. Mayor Pro Tem Venturi determined a quorum to be present, and opened the meeting.

PRESENT: Mayor Pro Tem Venturi, Commissioners White, Overcash, Summers and Winfrey, and Town Administrator Dimond.

Absent: Mayor Sage.

Commissioner Summers commented that the Cross Connection and Backflow program was almost the same as initially approved, just with a few small changes made by Jesse Burgess in Public Works. He also stressed that the changes needed to be passed before the special meeting on Cross Connection and Backflow taking place before the upcoming Town Board Meeting on Tuesday, March 3, 2015.

Motion: Commissioner Summers motioned to approve the revised Cross Connection and Backflow program, Commissioner Winfrey seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

It was determined to leave Cross Connection and Backflow program approval on the agenda, with a note that it had been approved and to move the Rotary Club presentation to after public comments (to item number 4).

Commissioner Overcash expressed an interest in making a motion during Tuesday's meeting to adopt a dragon as the official Town Mascot of Oriental. Mayor Pro Tem Venturi advised putting some more thought into the proposal, sighting worries over religious connections when the idea had been brought up in the past.

Motion: Commissioner Overcash motioned to adjourn, Commissioner White seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

The meeting adjourned at 4:09PM.
