If the sign is found to be not in compliance with the application and the Ordinances, I agree to remove it immediately or the Town will have the sign removed at my expense. I further understand that if at any time the sign is determined to be a traffic hazard or cause unreasonable interference of normal pedestrian or vehicular traffic in the area, an officer of the Oriental Police Department has the right to request that the sign be removed within 24 hours of said officer's request. If the sign in question is not removed per the request, a penalty will be assessed. It is the responsibility of the applicant to keep the sign administrator aware of any change of address/contact information.

If the applicant is not the owner of the property at the proposed sign location, the owner shall also sign the permit application.

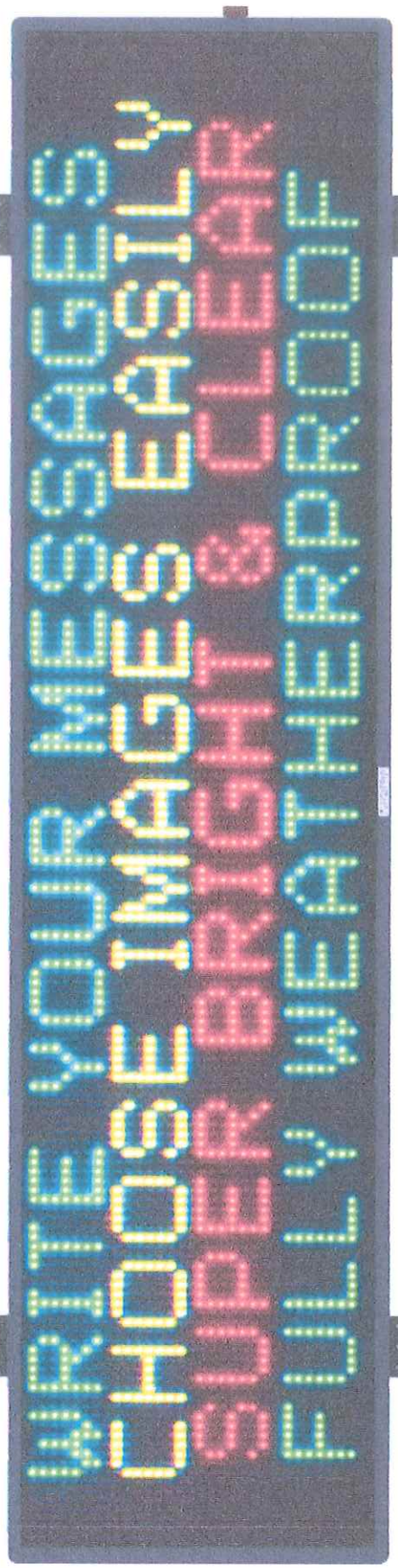
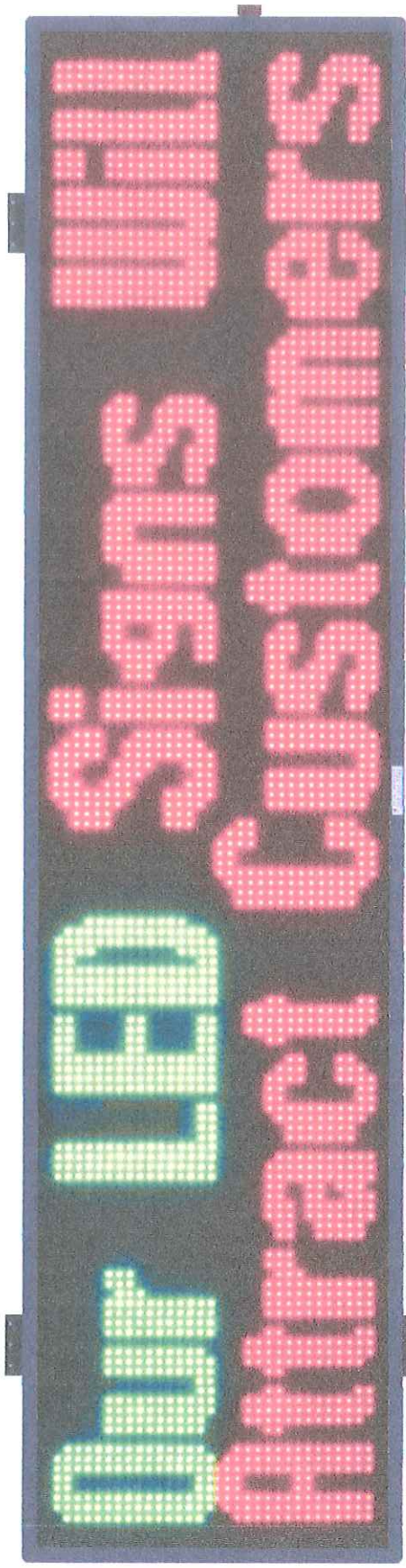
